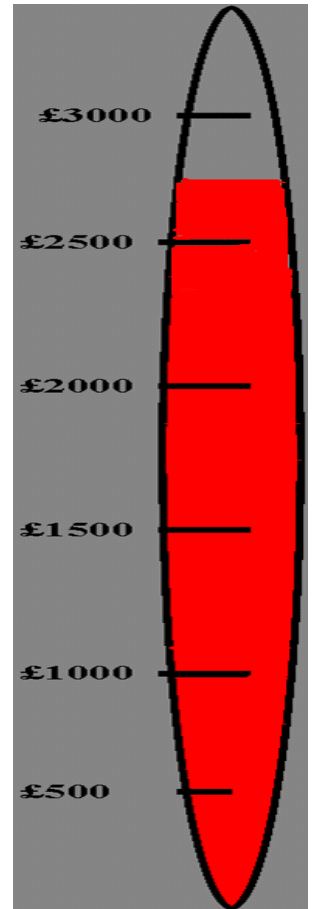
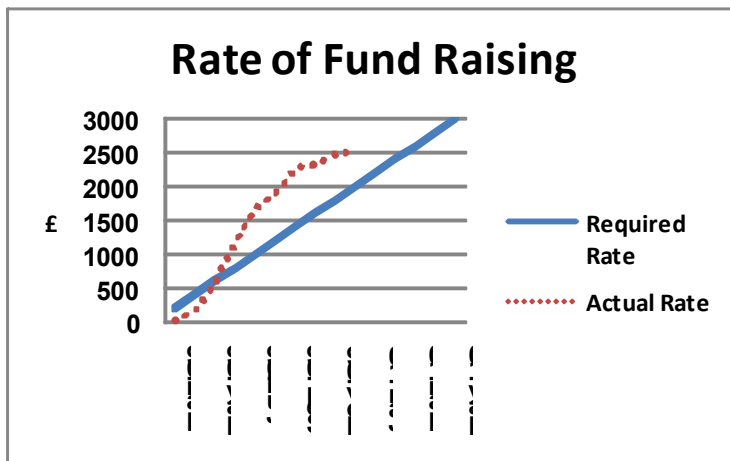
I hope you have all got your Christmas trees up as it is less than a week until Christmas!
